Minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 5, 2019 1001 Partridge Drive, Ventura, California

Chairman Kildee called the meeting to order at 8:32 a.m.

1. Roll Call: The Clerk of the Board called the roll. The following Board Members were present:

It was moved by Director Araiza, seconded by Director Hernandez, to approve the Consent Agenda, as presented. VOTE: Araiza, Hernandez, Kildee, Jones, Nast, and Perello were in favor; the motion carried 6-0.

Tina Rivera, Director of Finance, gave the presentation.

It was moved by Director Jones, seconded by Director Perello, to approve and authorize the Board Chair to sign, Amendment No. 6 (RE: additional funding) to July 18, 1991 Agreement Providing Funds for Investigation Regarding Tierra Rejada Landfill and authorizing expenditure of funds up to \$120,000 through 2024. VOTE: Araiza, Hernandez, Kildee, Jones, Nast, and Perello were in favor; the motion carried 6-0.

11. <u>Board of Directors Ratification of Contract No. 19-036 with Pride Construction</u> <u>Engineering Services for Storm Water Construction Services at the Toland Road</u> <u>Landfill</u>

Matt Baumgardner Director of Operations; gave the presentation.

It was moved by Director Hernandez, seconded by Director Nast, to ratify Contract No. 19-036 with Pride Construction Engineering Services (August 10, 2019) for storm water construction services in an amount not to exceed \$397,239. VOTE: Araiza, Hernandez, Kildee, Jones, Nast, and Perello were in favor; the motion carried 6-0.

19. <u>Board Member Comments</u>

Director Perello acknowledged a recent editorial written by Director Jones and noted that he attended the funeral of Neal Andrews, former City Council Member of the City of Ventura. Director Perello then shared his recollections about a meeting that he had with the Board Chairman, Legal Counsel, and General Manager following the last VRSD Board Meeting in July.

Legal Counsel Robert Kwong noted that the substance of this meeting was and is confidential and protected by the attorney-client privilege and should not be discussed as a part of the Board Member Comments

Directors Nast and Jones asked questions about Brown Act Open Meetings Law education and application. Mr. Kwong responded that their questions would be best handled when the revised Bylaws agenda item is taken up by the Board on September 19, 2019 Board meeting.

To accommodate Tara Mazzanti's, Oxnard Assistant City Attorney, request to speak to the Board, Chair Kildee reopened Public Comment (Agenda Item No. 4) at 10:02 a.m. Ms. Mazzanti then requested a Microsoft Word version the proposed VRSD Bylaws under Agenda Item No. 9, which Legal Counsel noted was improper since this request should have been considered when Agenda Item No. 9 was heard previously. Legal Counsel, however, agreed to take this request under consideration. With no further comment, public comment was closed at 10:05 a.m.

Chair Kildee reported on attending the California Association of Sanitation Agencies (CASA) Annual Conference in San Diego, August 21-23, 2019.

20. <u>General Manager Comments</u>

Mr. Theisen gave an update on the Conditional Use Permit Modification for the Toland Road Landfill stating that the publication of Notice of Preparation was

imminent. Rincon Consultants continued to work on the Environmental Impact Report (EIR). Another scoping meeting will be held within the next two months.

Mr. Theisen acknowledged his attendance at the meeting between Chairman Kildee, Director Perello, Legal Counsel Kwong, following the last Board meeting but did not discuss the substance of that confidential meeting.
