THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 1st day of July 2021, by and between OJAI VALLEY SCHOOL ("OVS") and VENTURA REGIONAL SANITATION DISTRICT, a public agency formed pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 4700 et seq. ("VRSD"). Together, OVS and VRSD shall be referred to herein as Parties.

RECITALS

- A. On June 18, 2015, OVS and VRSD entered into Contract No. 15-021, Agreement for Water & Wastewater Facilities Services ("Agreement"), wherein VRSD agreed to provide operation and maintenance services at OVS's wastewater treatment plant as requested by OVS (collectively "Services"); and
- B. On June 21, 2018, OVS and VRSD agreed to renew and extend the Agreement for three additional years, and entered into Amendment No. 1 to Contract No. 15-021 (Contract 15-021-1); and
- C. OVS and VRSD acknowledge and agree that they desire to renew and extend the Agreement for one additional year, and that this can be accomplished by amending the Agreement (Contract No. 15-021) accordingly.

AMENDMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- NOW, THEREFORE, based upon valuable consideration below and the recitals above, it is mutually agreed by and between the Parties, in accordance with ARTICLE 3: AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION of the Agreement governing the amendment of the Agreement, as follows:
- 1. The following language shall replace the original provisions of Section 3.1 of ARTICLE 1: AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION:

"3.1 Effective Date

This Agreement shall commence on July 1, 2015 and shall expire on June 30, 2022, unless extended by mutual agreement of the Parties or terminated as hereinafter provided."

2015 ALIC -4 AM 9: 56 AGREEMENT FOR WATER & WASTEWATER FACILITIES SERVICES BETWEEN OJAI VALLEY SCHOOL AND VENTURA REGIONAL SANITATION DISTRICT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 18th day of June 2015 by and between OJAI VALLEY SCHOOL, a California non-profit corporation, hereinafter "OVS", and the VENTURA REGIONAL SANITATION DISTRICT, a public agency formed pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 4700 et. seq., hereinafter "VRSD".

RECITALS

- A. OVS is the owner of a wastewater treatment facility which is referred to herein as "FACILITIES" and located at 10820 Reeves Road, Ojai, California, Assessor's Parcel Number 030-030-020, located in the Ventura County area; and
- B. OVS desires to enter into an agreement with VRSD for operation and maintenance at OVS's wastewater treatment plant as requested by OVS (collectively "SERVICES"); and
- C. VRSD has the authority, pursuant to Health & Safety Code Section 4700 et. seq. and Public Contract Code §20782, and capability to provide the requested services relative to OVS and is willing to perform such services for OVS.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements set forth, the parties agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

ARTICLE 1: RETENTION OF VRSD

- 1.1 VRSD shall provide services to OVS on the conditions hereinafter set forth. OVS's business manager shall administer this Agreement for OVS. It is expressly understood that the relationship between OVS and VRSD is that of an independent contractor and VRSD is not, and shall not be deemed, an employee of OVS.
- 1.2 VRSD shall assign a Staff Coordinator or Liaison satisfactory to the OVS to work directly with OVS's designee in connection with VRSD's services to be performed under this Agreement. Such assignment shall be made by written notice to OVS.
- 1.3 VRSD accepts the relationship of trust and confidence established between VRSD and OVS by this agreement. VRSD agrees to furnish efficient business administration, personnel services, and superintendence and to use its best efforts to perform the work in the most expeditious and economical manner consistent with the public interest and applicable regulations. VRSD shall provide the services described in Article 2 within the limitations of an annual budget total approved by both agencies.

1.4 The parties acknowledge that OVS retains exclusive authority and budgetary discretion relating to the funding of OVS's operation and maintenance of its facilities, including provision for acquiring, repairing, maintaining and replacing OVS's existing equipment, structures and facilities and installation of new equipment, structures and facilities.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF SERVICES

See attached Exhibit A.

ARTICLE 3: AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION

3.1 Effective Date

This Agreement shall commence on July 1, 2015 and shall expire on June 30, 2018, unless extended by mutual agreement of the parties or terminated as hereinafter provided.

3.2 Termination by OVS

This agreement may be terminated by OVS upon the following terms and conditions:

a. OVS may terminate this agreement in the event of a material default by VRSD in any of VRSD's obligations hereunder. For purposes of this Agreement, a material default shall be defined as VRSD's failure to perform any of the obligations contained in Article 2 herein. Such termination by OVS shall be effective only if the default remains uncured upon the expiration of sixty (60) days after VRSD's receipt of written notice from OVS specifying the default. Termination of this Agreement because of a material default of VRSD shall not relieve VRSD from liability for such default. In case of termination of this Agreement by OVS for material default of VRSD, VRSD shall be entitled to amounts actually earned as of the date of the default. OVS may also terminate this agreement if OVS and VRSD cannot agree on annual budget for any fiscal year during the term of this agreement.

3.3 <u>Termination by VRSD</u>

This agreement may be terminated by VRSD upon the following terms and conditions:

VRSD may terminate this agreement in the event of a material default by OVS in any of OVS's obligations hereunder. For purposes of this Agreement, a material default shall be defined as OVS's failure to perform any of the obligations contained in ARTICLE 5. Such termination by VRSD shall be effective only if the default remains uncured upon the expiration of sixty (60) days after OVS's receipt of written notice from VRSD specifying the default. Termination of this Agreement because of a material default of OVS shall not relieve OVS from liability for such default.

ARTICLE 4: OPERATIONAL COSTS AND COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES

4.1 Operational Costs

a. Operational Costs. OVS shall pay to VRSD the entire cost to VRSD of performing the services within the limitations of the annual budget total approved by both agencies. OVS shall be billed only for costs incurred. OVS shall not be billed for costs exceeding the total budgeted amount and VRSD shall not be obligated to perform work that would exceed the total budgeted amount without amendment

of the jointly adopted budget specified in OVS's approved budget. A budget shall be adopted by both agencies following annual review and consultation and each succeeding budget total shall become a part of this agreement. For the purpose of this agreement, the entire cost to OVS shall include:

- b. For personnel services, the VRSD billing rate associated with the classification of each individual performing services, as shown in the jointly adopted budget and associated billing rate schedule.
- c. For services and supplies, the actual cost of the materials and services purchased, to which overhead has been applied and included in the jointly adopted budget. The overhead amount may be reviewed and adjusted for each successive fiscal year (7/1-6/30) this agreement is in effect. VRSD shall, pursuant to its own procedures, practices, and regulations, arrange for the purchase of and payment for all service and supply items.
- d. For equipment and machinery, the VRSD billing rate associated with the equipment or machinery used, as shown in the jointly adopted budget and associated billing rate schedule.

4.2 <u>Compensation for Services</u>

- (a) On or before the tenth (10th) working day following the end of any month for which payments are required to be made under this Agreement ("Billing Period"), VRSD shall mail to OVS a bill setting forth the fees for such prior month based on approved work and materials. Payment is due thirty (30) days after the invoice date, OVS shall present payment to VRSD for full amount of such fees.
- (b) If OVS disputes any amount billed by VRSD in any Billing Statement, OVS shall nonetheless pay the undisputed amount and shall mail to VRSD detailed written objection within twenty (20) days of the receipt of such billing statement indicating the amount that is being disputed and providing all reasons then known to OVS for its objection to or disagreement with such amount. If OVS and VRSD are not able to resolve such dispute within twenty (20) working days after OVS's objection, either party may pursue legal remedies.
- (c) If payment in full of any bill rendered by VRSD is not made as required, the unpaid balance shall bear an additional interest charge of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month until full payment is made. VRSD shall also be entitled to recover its reasonable expenses, including attorneys fees, incurred in obtaining payment of any unpaid balance hereunder. OVS may, at its option, pay all or any portion of a bill under written protest and bring action to recover same.

4.3 Existing Fixed Assets

All existing OVS fixed assets, rolling stock, inventory and supplies of and accessory to the WASTEWATER FACILITIES are and will remain the property of OVS. VRSD is acting solely as an agent on behalf of OVS in its acquisition, use, and disposition of such items. VRSD shall not enter into contracts for acquisition or disposal of OVS fixed assets without prior approval of OVS.

4.4 Records

VRSD shall maintain all accounting in conformance with generally accepted accounting principles and all applicable laws and regulations.

4.5 Examination of Records

VRSD agrees that OVS shall have, during normal business hours, access to and the right to examine any directly pertinent books, documents, papers, and records of VRSD and of all the transactions relating to this Agreement.

ARTICLE 5: OVS'S RESPONSIBILITY

5.1 OVS shall provide VRSD, without charge, all information available to OVS and assistance in regard to obtaining any work performed by OVS or others in connection with the WASTEWATER FACILITIES, including but not limited to: pertinent maps, reports, plans and specifications, necessary legal information, etc., which work or material is available to OVS and which is required in connection with services.

ARTICLE 6: INSURANCE

- 6.1 VRSD, at its sole discretion, shall determine the method to be used in the management of its risk. VRSD shall have the right to self-insure or provide coverage through the California Sanitation Risk Management Authority or provide certificates of insurance to OVS in amounts not less than those specified below:
 - a. Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability in accordance with applicable laws.
- b. General & Automobile Liability with combined single limit of \$5,000,000 for bodily injury, death or property damage.
- 6.2 VRSD may retain risks of accidental loss which occur with predictable frequency and will not have serious adverse effect on VRSD's fiscal position. When insurance is purchased, Certificates of Insurance evidencing coverage shall be provided by VRSD prior to commencement of work under this Agreement. These certificates shall name OVS as Additional Insured and contain a provision that coverage afforded under the policies will not be canceled until at least 30 days' prior written notice has been given to OVS.
- 6.3 VRSD shall not be responsible for damage or loss by any peril to facilities and equipment owned by OVS other than as provided in Article 7.1.

ARTICLE 7: HOLD HARMLESS

- 7.1 Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, VRSD shall indemnify, defend, and hold OVS free and harmless from any fines levied by the RWQCB and all claims, demands, liabilities, loss or injury to, or death of, any person, including, but not limited to, employees of OVS and damage to or destruction of property including, but not limited to, property of OVS; provided said fines, claims, demands, liability or loss arise out of the performance by VRSD of the services required hereunder and are caused by a negligent act or failure to act of VRSD.
- 7.2 Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, OVS shall indemnify, defend, and hold VRSD free and harmless from any fines levied by the RWQCB and all claims, demands, liabilities, loss or injury to, or death of, any person, including, but not limited to, employees of VRSD and damage to or destruction of property including, but not limited to, property of VRSD; provided said fines, claims, demands, liability or loss are caused by a negligent act or failure to act of OVS. In this regard, OVS

acknowledges the provisions of Article 1.4 and agrees to indemnify, defend and hold VRSD harmless from fines, claims, demands, liability or loss arising from OVS's failure to take action, or make budgetary provision, for the replacement of existing equipment, structures or facilities, or the acquisition of new equipment, structures or facilities.

ARTICLE 8: TERMS

No alteration or variation of the terms of this Agreement shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by the parties. No oral understanding or agreement not incorporated herein shall be binding on any of the parties hereto.

ARTICLE 9: ASSIGNMENT

Neither party shall assign nor transfer its interest in this Agreement without the written consent, of the other, which written consent shall not be withheld except for good and reasonable cause.

ARTICLE 10: ARTICLE HEADINGS

Article headings in this Agreement are for convenience only and are not intended to be used in interpreting or construing the terms, covenants, and conditions of this Agreement.

ARTICLE 11: PARTIAL INVALIDITY

If any term, covenant, condition, or provision of this contract is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, or unenforceable, the remainder of the provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect, and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated thereby.

ARTICLE 12: NOTICES

All notices or other official correspondence relating to contractual matters between the parties hereto shall be made by depositing same first-class, postage paid mail addressed as follows:

or to such other address as either party may designate hereinafter in writing delivered to the other party. All notices shall be deemed to have been received three (3) days after mailing.

ARTICLE 14: NO WAIVER

No failure or delay by either party in asserting any of its rights and remedies as to any default of the other party shall operate as a waiver of the default, of any subsequent or other default, or any of either party's rights or remedies. No such delay shall deprive VRSD of its right to institute and maintain any action or proceeding which may be necessary to protect, assert or enforce any rights or remedies arising out of this agreement or the performance of this agreement.

ARTICLE 15: CALIFORNIA LAW

This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed pursuant to the laws of the State of California. The parties agree that venue for any litigation arising from this agreement shall be County of Ventura Superior Court.

Exhibit "A"

Scope of Services

Water & Wastewater Facilities

- a) VRSD shall provide an operator certified by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) to operate FACILITIES. Operator shall check the wastewater facility 3 times each week. VRSD shall also designate operators and other personnel as "standby" to respond to after-hours emergency calls.
- b) VRSD shall perform all necessary operational and laboratory analyses presently required by the standards and regulations of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB).
- c) VRSD will conduct groundwater monitoring of the 3 groundwater wells as required by the RWQCB.
- c) VRSD shall maintain proper laboratory records and submit all required reports to the RWQCB. VRSD shall furnish OVS a copy of all reports submitted to the regulatory agency.
- d) VRSD shall maintain all treatment process equipment in good working order. Such maintenance shall include checking and necessary lubrication of blowers, air diffusers, effluent lift stations and other on-site equipment.
- e) VRSD shall perform housekeeping in such a manner to maintain the FACILITIES in a clean and sanitary condition.
- f) VRSD shall operate OVS's FACILITIES in conformance with all operational requirements of the regulatory agency, so far as is physically possible and practical within the FACILITIES' technical and economic limitations.
- g) VRSD shall furnish a monthly report to OVS reflecting the activities of VRSD under this Agreement for the preceding month.

Other Services.

VRSD shall perform other services requested in writing by OVS, provided the services are reasonably related to the purpose of this Agreement, further provided additional funds are authorized by OVS. Verbal authorization shall be accepted only in the case of emergency, and must be followed up within 5 working days with the usual written authorization regarding provision of service and funding at VRSD's current rates.
