14. <u>General Manager Comments</u>

Chris Theisen, General Manager, updated the Board on the progress of meeting certain conditions in Toland Road Landfill Conditional Use Permit:

- <u>Condition 55b: Offsite Air Monitoring.</u> Monitoring is scheduled to begin the first week in May.
- <u>Condition 57: Dust Control Monitoring.</u> Equipment is now online. Data collection for this year-long monitoring study has begun.

Mr. Theisen, had Mr. Jones, Director of Operations, provide an update on the recent storm damage the Toland Road Landfill.

Mr. Jones gave a visual presentation that showed storm damage to slopes causing mud slides that are adversely affecting the perimeter stormwater channel that keeps water off of the landfill area. Staff will look to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for funding assistance.

Director Juarez asked when it would be possible for Directors to tour the landfill. Mr. Jones responded that now that the storms are less frequent and the mud is drying up, a tour can be arranged.
