# **VENTURA REGIONAL SANITATION DISTRICT**

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 1, 2023 4105 W. Gonzalez Road, Oxnard, California

Chairperson Kildee called the meeting to order at 8:32 a.m.

General Manager Chris Theisen discussed some minor edits to the contract that is being considered, in Agenda Item 7, Approve, and Authorize the Board Chair to Sign, VRSD Contract No. 23-002 with SCS Field Services for Construction Services Related to the Replacement of the Toland Road Landfill Gas Collection System Flare

5. <u>Approval of Minutes:</u> May 4, 2023 Regular Meeting

Halter, Juarez, Kildee, Lang, Newman, Ulrich, and Villaseñor. AGAINST: Perello and Ulrich). Directors Hernandez and Zaragoza abstained.

6. <u>Approve, and Adopt Board Resolution No. 23-01 to Collect Onsite Wastewater</u> <u>Treatment System Sewer Service Charges Regarding Malibu Bay Club Parcels on</u> <u>County of Ventura Property Tax Rolls for Fiscal Year 2023-24</u>

Tina Rivera, Director of Finance, gave the staff report.

Chairperson Kildee opened the public hearing at 8:49 a.m.

Bob Honoré, Malibu Bay Club parcel owner, addressed the Board seeking clarification on the sewer service fees being charged on the tax roll versus fees listed in a recent unrelated communication he received. He was given clarification that the hearing was solely for placing the sewer service fees on the tax rolls.

With no one else wishing to speak, Chairperson Kildee closed the public hearing.

*It was moved by Director Perello, seconded by Director Newman to* A) Hold a public hearing in accordance with Health & Safety Code §5473 *et seq.*; and B) Approve and adopt the report (Attachment 1) which contains the Assessor Parcel Numbers ("APNs") and the corresponding amount of VRSD sewer service charges proposed for collection on the County of Ventura Property Tax Rolls; and C) Approve and adopt VRSD Resolution No. 23-01 to Collect VRSD Sewer Service Charges on the County of Ventura Property Tax Rolls for Malibu Bay Parcels (Attachment 2); and D) Authorize and direct VRSD staff to coordinate collection of VRSD sewer service charges for Malibu Bay Club parcels on the general Ventura County tax rolls with the County Auditor-Controller, Assessor, and Tax Collector, and to submit to the Auditor-Controller all required forms and data needed to place direct assessments on the tax roll. ROLL CALL VOTE: Motion carried 9-0 (FOR: Halter, Hernandez, Juarez, Kildee, Lang, Newman, Ulrich, Villaseñor, and Zaragoza).

7. <u>Approve, and Authorize the Board Chair to Sign, VRSD Contract No. 23-002 with</u> <u>SCS Field Services for Construction Services Related to the Replacement of the</u> <u>Toland Road Landfill Gas Collection System Flare</u>

Chris Theisen, General Manager, stated mutually agreed minor changes to VRSD Contract No. 23-002: 1) Change the wording in Article I, sections A and B from "Design Construction services to Landfill Construction services; and 2) the contractor signer was changed from Chris Forland to Galen Petoyan.

Richard Jones, Director of Operations, gave the staff report.

*It was moved by Director Halter, seconded by Director Hernandez,* to A) Approve, and Authorize the Board Chair to sign, VRSD Contract No. 23-002 with SCS Field Services, to include the changes made orally by the General Manager, in an amount not to exceed \$1,462,081 for the Landfill Gas Collection System Ultra Low NOx Flare Installation Project at the Toland Road Landfill; and B) Authorize transfer of

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\$240,000 from the Toland Road Landfill Main Access Road Repair fund (01-900-52082-499903120) and \$600,000 from the Leachate Capital Project (01-900-52074-499583120); and Appropriate \$128,406 from General Fund Balance to help cover VRSD No. 23-002 costs. ROLL CALL VOTE: Motion carried 9-0 (FOR: Halter, Hernandez, Juarez, Kildee, Lang, Newman, Ulrich, Villaseñor, and Zaragoza).

8. <u>Board of Directors Workshop for Review and Comment on the Proposed Fiscal</u> Years 2023-24 and 2024-25 Two Year Budget

Tina Rivera, Director of Finance, gave the staff report.

Director Lang left the meeting at 10:19 a.m. and did not return.
