## DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

The **Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator I** is responsible for the operation of assigned facilities and resolution of the majority of routine operational problems. Assignments in this position may vary but usually include one large or several smaller plants on a regular basis. This is the entry level technical class in the Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator series which allows the incumbent to develop journey level knowledge and abilities. Incumbents are primarily assigned to work at smaller facilities and/or with a higher level certified operator or supervisor.

The **Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator II** is responsible for the operation of assigned facilities and resolution of the majority of routine operational problems. Assignments in this position may vary but usually include one large or several smaller plants on a regular basis. This is the journey level technical class in the Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator series which works with a great level of independence as allowed by their certification and assignment area.

The **Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator III** is responsible for the operation of assigned facilities and resolution of the majority of routine operational problems. Assignments in this position may vary but usually include one large or several smaller plants on a regular basis. These are the advanced journey level technical class in the Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator series which provides training and direction to Water and Wastewater personnel and performs the most complex operations and maintenance activities as allowed by their certification.

**EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS**-*Any equivalent combination of experience and education that would provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the required knowledge and abilities would be:*

**Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator I:** One (1) year of increasingly responsible experience as a Water/Wastewater Apprentice. **Education:** Equivalent to a high school diploma. **License/Certificate:** Possession of a Grade I Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Certificate issued by the California State Water Resource Control Board (SWRCB) or equivalent certification issued by a reciprocal state to California.

Possession of, or ability to obtain, a valid Class C California driver's license, and a driving record acceptable for insurability.

Possession of water certification from the California Department of Health Services is desirable. Depending on assignment, a valid Class B driver's license may be required.

## Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator II

**Experience:** Two (2) years of increasingly responsible experience as a Water/Wastewater Treatment Operator.

**Education:** Equivalent to a high school diploma.

**License/Certificate:** Possession of a Grade II Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Certificate issued by the California State Water Resource Control Board (SWRCB) or equivalent certification issued by a reciprocal state to California. Possession of, or ability to obtain, a valid Class C California driver's license, and a driving record acceptable for insurability. Possession of water certification from the California Department of Health Services is desirable. Depending on assignment, a valid Class B driver's license may be required.

## Water and Wastewater Treatment Operator III

**Experience:** Three (3) years of increasingly responsible experience as a Water/Wastewater Treatment Operator.

**Education:** Equivalent to a high school diploma.

**License/Certificate:** Possession of a Grade III Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Certificate issued by the California State Water Resource Control Board (SWRCB) or equivalent certification issued by a reciprocal state to California. Possession of, or ability to obtain, a valid Class C California driver's license, and a driving record acceptable for insurability. Possession of water certification from the California Department of Health Services is desirable. Depending on assignment, a valid Class B driver's license may be required.
